

The following is a provisional list of activities the Trusts will be carrying out at Dudmaston Estate, near Bridgnorth, over the next few months. <u>DATE</u>	<u>ACTIVITY</u>
Sunday 15 th January 2012	Orchard Work: Completion of hedge-laying & preliminary tree pruning of various fruit tree varieties to promote healthy growth
Sunday 19 th February 2012	Orchard Work: Final pruning of any uncompleted trees from previous month, planting of new boundary hedge using a mix of native species.
Sunday 18 th March 2012	Tree Weeding: Removal of young trees from Big Pool Dam, in order to maintain wildflower meadow as per management regime.
Sunday 15 th April 2012	Nest Box Construction: Bird box building and installation for a variety of species at a number of sites on Dudmaston Estate.
Sunday 20 th May 2012	Nest Box Construction: Bird box building and installation for a variety of species at a number of sites on Dudmaston Estate.
Sunday 17 th June 2012	Guided Estate Walk: The history of forest management at Dudmaston will be explained on a guided walk.

10am to 3.30pm meeting at the Estate Yard - The Holt - next door to Dudmaston Sawmill. You'll need to wear appropriate outdoor clothing, stout boots, and bring lunch including drinks.
