Monday December 5th

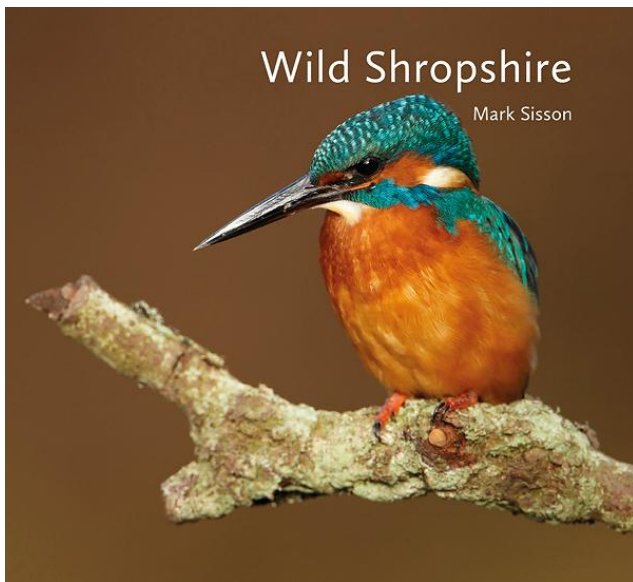
Trip to the Arctic *Hazel Bows and Tessa Huggett*

Urban Jungle or Triumph of Nature? ***Pete Lambert***



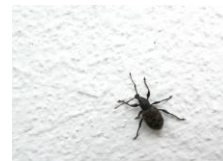
