#### Outline of Hazard/Task: Use of SWT vehicles by staff & volunteers

Due to new Tier 5 restriction as of 6.1.21 the following highlighted amendments have been made until further notice. Specifically: Volunteers will be asked to make their own way to work sites. SWT staff can share vehicles *if it is essential*.

**Additional:** As operational activities increase, all vehicles will have a named main driver, named user or users and specific limits on passenger numbers to reduce potential spread of Covid-19.

#### **Coleham Yard**

- Gates and lock up doors strict social distancing will be maintained. Leavers, bolts, padlocks etc. will be sanitised after use.
- **Equipment** will be stored away and no equipment will be left for others to store away.
- **Rubbish brought in from sites** this will be disposed of safely and hygienically by the staff member bringing it in.

#### The Cut

- Car park space Only Trust vehicles allowed in car parking space
- Signage To reduce congestion with deliveries, staff, volunteers & customers signage will outline 'Parking for Shropshire Wildlife Trust pool vehicles only' and displayed on each parking bay. Parking will be limited on the parking apron with signage stating "Pick up and drop off for Shropshire Wildlife Trust only. Limited to 10 minutes"

#### Abbey Foregate carpark

- **Public car park** with risks of Covid-19 being present both on hard surfaces and in droplets of passing users, social distancing and washing hands for 20 seconds is essential with use of hand sanitiser (min 60% alcohol content) if no handwashing facilities are available.
- **Social distancing** must be adhered to.

#### Others (whilst out on Trust work)

- Public car parks risks of Covid-19 being present on both hard surfaces and in droplets of passing users.
- Social distancing Must be adhered to.
- Handwashing As above.

Vehicle specifics:

#### Minibuses

Only the driver and one staff passenger maximum can travel in this vehicle if essential.

#### Truck

- Only the driver and one staff passenger maximum can travel in this vehicle if essential.

#### Ranger

- Only the driver and one staff passenger maximum will travel in this vehicle if essential.
- The passenger must be sat in the seat furthest away from the driver.

### 2x Renault vans

- Only the driver and one staff passenger maximum will travel in this vehicle if essential.
- The passenger must be sat in the seat furthest away from the driver.

#### Toyota Yaris

- Only the driver and one staff passenger maximum will travel in this vehicle if essential.
- The passenger must be sat in the seat furthest away from the driver.

#### Peugeot estate

- Only the driver and one staff passenger maximum will travel in this vehicle if essential.
- Any passenger will sit in the rear seat diagonally away from the driver



Advisory note: All windows to be opened if environmental conditions allow. Individuals may wear face masks if preferred.
