- For engagement work related to children, We have a robust application process for education roles which includes a probationary period, two references, an induction, compulsory training in Child Protection and a satisfactory DBS check (a trial session to see what is involved with the role is exempt from this). Volunteers must not apply for this role working with children if they are prohibited from working with children.
