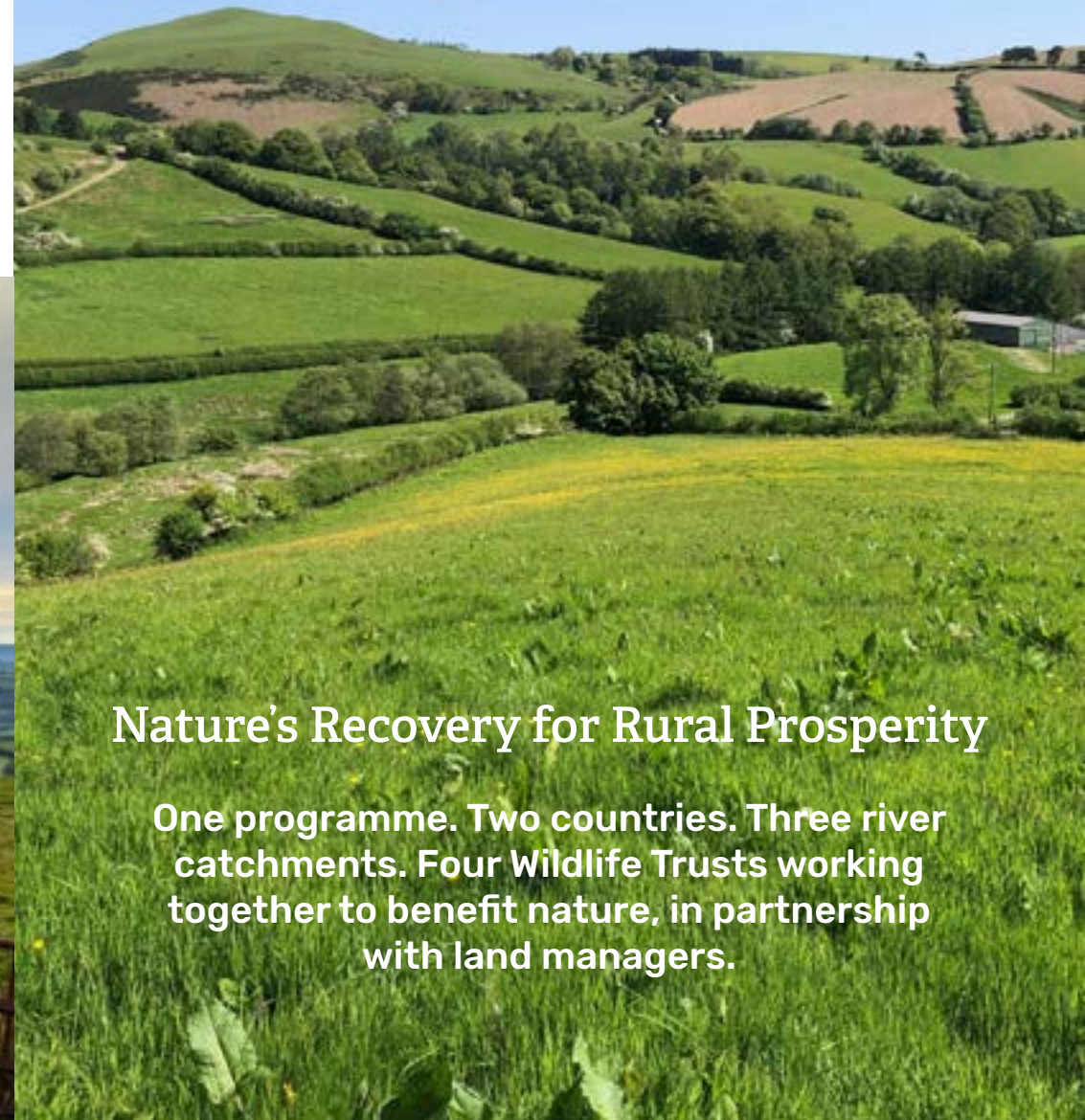

What is Wilder Marches?

The Wilder Marches is a landscape recovery programme hosted by The Wildlife Trusts of Shropshire, Montgomeryshire, Herefordshire and Radnorshire.

Wilder Marches aims to create more spaces where people and nature thrive. It looks to build a network of estates, farms, forests, nature reserves and commons working to enable nature's recovery at scale and supporting the implementation of nature-based solutions.

As part of the programme, we hope to engage with and connect people to environmental market opportunities; unlocking economic potential in the area and generating viable mechanisms for sustainable land use.

During our programme development phase we will be seeking input to help us shape what a 'Wilder Marches' would look like and how we implement this.
